The *Forged by the Fire* initiative is a series of four retreats for young adult men hosted by the Vocations Office. These retreats are aimed at forming young men into ardent disciples of Jesus Christ and sending them forth for mission in the world and in the Church. A second program to further this effort, *Fraternus*, trains adult Catholic men in parishes to serve as mentors for young Catholic men. *Fraternus* mentors are formed to lead young men into virtuous Catholic manhood. From this mentorship, tremendous fruits, including healthy Catholic marriages and vocations to the priesthood, are expected to emerge. Both of these initiatives aim to stem the tide of the alarming rate at which young men are leaving the Church.
